

# **Integrated Care Fellowship**

#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

Under the supervision of the Nursing Supervisor, provides a range of health care services, within the scope of the profession's practice to individuals who are served by Shiawassee Health & Wellness and Behavioral Health Home benefit (BHH) with primary severe, persistent mental illness, developmental disabilities, and/or serious emotional disturbances and co-occurring complex medical conditions. A team approach is utilized to ensure integration between physical and mental health needs with a focus on managing chronic disease and an emphasis on promotion of preventative care and self-management health care strategies. Promotes mental health recovery, wellness, and full participation within the community for individuals in a manner where practice is trauma informed, co-occurring capable, person/family centered and integrated with other health care providers.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

Some coursework towards a degree in nursing or closely related field Good communication skills, verbal and written Desire to work with the vulnerable individuals in our community who experience mental illness and/or

developmental disabilities.

# **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- Researches, develops and provides education to individuals served and guardians about medication, 1. chronic conditions, health and wellness related issues individually or in a group setting.
- 2. Assesses individuals served to determine their eligibility for BHH program or additional services.
- 3. Researches, develops and provides material regarding integrated healthcare to SHW staff, individuals served and their quardians.
- 4. Supports BHH team with developing and monitoring goals, objectives and implementation plans for services that relate to improving individuals served overall health, independence in self-care and ability to meet health care needs in their community.
- 5. Supports RN with reviewing results of lab tests, monitors electronic health record dashboard for past due laboratory testing and works with individuals served and primary service provider to complete; Alerts psychiatrist and primary health care provider to abnormal results. Provides patient centered education on results as necessary.
- 6. Researching community resources and providing support with access and connection to resources to individuals served.
- 7. Identify and reduce barriers for individuals served to increase access to care and supports.
- 8. Providing additional support to psychiatry department and/or BHH as needed.
